DALBY Sutton Bonnington and then to Loughborough where Thomas and his wife Elizabeth died of the plague in 1609

EDENBOROUGH John, Scarrington c.1700
KEMP or HUGGINS Orston c1600 incomplete

BROOKS searching for a James who was a gardener, the father of Ann Thraves who was born in 1834 at Holme Pierrepont
